### Recipients of the 1<sup>st</sup> cycle of *licenciatura* and *mestrado integrado*:

1. Can apply for enrollment and enroll in the 1st cycle of undergraduate and master's studies of ULisboa:
  - a) The holders of qualification that, in the country in which it was obtained, confers them the right to apply and enroll in higher education in that country;
  - b) Holders of a Portuguese secondary education diploma or legally equivalent qualification.
2. The validation of ownership referred to in paragraph 1 (a) shall be made by the competent authority of the country in which the qualification was obtained.
3. The qualification equivalence referred to in paragraph b) of paragraph 1 is defined by *Portaria n.º 224/2006*, of March 8, and by *Portaria n.º 699/2006*, of July 12.

### Recipients of the 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle of *mestrado*:

- a) The holders of the degree of *licenciado* or legal equivalent;
- b) Holders of a foreign higher academic degree awarded followed by a first cycle of studies organized in accordance with the principles of the Bologna Process by a State adhering to this Process;
- c) Holders of a foreign higher academic degree that is recognized as meeting the objectives of the degree of *licenciado* by the Scientific Commission competent in the higher education institution where they wish to be admitted;
- d) Holders of an academic, scientific or professional curriculum recognized as attesting the capacity to carry out this cycle of studies by the Scientific Commission competent in the higher education institution where they wish to be admitted.

Final classification in Portuguese high school education, or equivalent, indicating the scale of classification in which it is expressed; ii. Academic qualification in accordance #2 e 5 with article 4;</li> <li>e) Diploma DEPLE or Diploma DIPLE, or B1 or B2 certificate issued by a ULisboa School, or B1 level declaration of Portuguese language and culture domain, whenever the candidate did not attend a Portuguese high school education;</li> <li>f) Statement of possession of pre-requisites required by the course of study to which the student applies or document validated by a MD - physician, certified by the Portuguese Medical Association (pre-requisites of Group A, B and D), or result of the assessment of the aptitude performed by the WFH (Group C, E and I prerequisites).</li> </ol> </li> <li>4.
